it is also a fascinating read on the history of ideas about labour in the late nineteenth century and in the interwar period. the work contains a great number of intriguing insights that form the basis of the subsequent volumes and can serve as an introduction to later works by rabinbach on industrialisation, fordism, the discipline of labour, and the state. the publication of this wonderful book marks a momentous and welcome reappraisal of labour. what is particularly useful about this book is that the authors seek to provide a detailed and comprehensive account of the historical development of the problem of labour in the west. anson rabinbachs book should now be added to the list of standard texts for anyone wishing to understand the history of the relation of work and leisure in the west. anson rabinbach is professor of history and the department of humanities at new york university. he is the author of the human motor: energy, fatigue, and the origins of modernity (princeton university press, 2010). in her book, kultur, wundt uses the terminology of biology to describe the relationships between people and their culture. she explains that these relationships are based on the fitness of the cultural forms to the individual. wundt believes that humans have a need for culture, just as plants and animals have a need for food and shelter. culture is the “substance” of a species, the “fuel” of individual beings, and the “breath of life” of a community. the decline of the concept of human energy in the industrial era coincided with the increasing importance of the metaphor of the machine. rabinbach illustrates this shift in his study of the french socialist and cultural theorist, jules verne, who was obsessed with the energy flows of the human body and worked to turn them to political and economic ends. by devising technologically inspired means to harness those flows for industrial production, verne anticipated the fordist model of the human motor. rabinbach also shows how the bolshevik management theorist, taylor, in his promulgation of the principles of scientific management, was as interested in the physiology of the human body as in the organization of industrial labor. in contrast to other utopian industrialists, taylor sought to put the body back into work in order to make it more productive. taylor developed a system for the management of industrial labor that paid particular attention to the human body. he promoted a system of wages and incentives designed to encourage a new type of worker who was more respectful of the needs and demands of the body. rabinbach shows how taylor was a strong advocate of the idea that the human body could be trained and trained to become a more rational and efficient machine.
